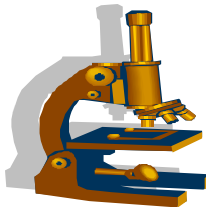

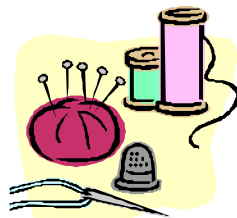

Tumbling: Have fun flipping safely around on the floor mats. It's a great way to stay in shape, learning cool acrobatic moves.

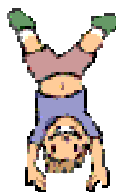
