<u>IN GENERAL:</u> Please remember that school supplies are needed throughout the whole year. With that in mind, you may want to stock up now and retain this list to restock later in the year.

 English classes: All classes need highlighters in 3 colors, ballpoint pens in black, blue and red, loose-leaf paper In addition: 9th grade: 1 inch binder with pockets and set of clear tab dividers 10th grade: 1 inch binder with pockets/clear front and set of clear tab dividers 2 pkgs of 5 X 8 lined index cards; colored pens; 3 highlighters 11th grade: 1-inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers. 12th grade: 1-inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers. 2 pkgs of 5 X 8 lined index cards AP English Language for 11th graders and AP Literature and Composition for 12th graders: 1-inch binder and a set of 5 dividers.

	History and Social Science classes : a 1½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper, 2 pocket folder with prongs Black and/or blue ballpoint pens AP History- 3 inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper.	
	Foreign Language classes : 2 inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper, Black and/or blue ballpoint pens Spanish I/III Regular and Honors- Headphones	
	Intergrated Physical Science: 1 one inch binder (one more if they are participating in Science Fair), 2 Composition notebooks, 1 two pocket folder	
	Biology: 3x5 notecards, 3 ring binder (or space in a binder for biology papers), loose leaf college ruled paper, at least 4 different colored writing utensils For Science Fair: one composition notebook with no labels or writing in it (students should not write their names on or in it), three-ring binder, 9 divider tabs, tri-fold presentation board	
	AP Biology: 3x5 notecards, 3 ring binder (or space in a binder for AP biology materials), loose	

leaf college ruled paper, at least 4 different colored writing utensils

	Anatomy Science classes: Three ring binder (or space in a binder for anatomy papers), loose leaf college ruled paper, colored pencils, 3x5 notecards
	Environmental Science : Three ring binder (or space in a binder for environmental science materials), 3 X 5 notecards, a pair of closed toed and waterproof shoes (rubber boots up to your calves are preferable), field-safe clothes that can get wet and dirty such as Columbia or a similar brand
	Physics, classes : 5 subject spiral notebook, 2 pocket folder, loose leaf college-ruled paper, 1 composition notebook
	Chemistry: 5 subject spiral notebook
	HOPE class : a 1 ½ inch duty binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, loose leaf collegeruled paper (You will also be asked to purchase Academy at the Lakes PE clothes: shorts and tshirts. They will be available for sale on campus on Orientation Day.)
	Computer and Video Electives: 2GB flashdrive
	Studio Art classes: Strathmore ST 455-3 9"x12" side spiral, 60lb, 100 pages.
	Theater classes: 1 inch black binder with 2 inside pockets
	Chorus: a 1½ inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover
	Band class : a 1 inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover; students must supply their own reeds for instruments
	Strings class : a 1 inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover, 2 dozen plastic sheet protectors with 3-hole punch
