

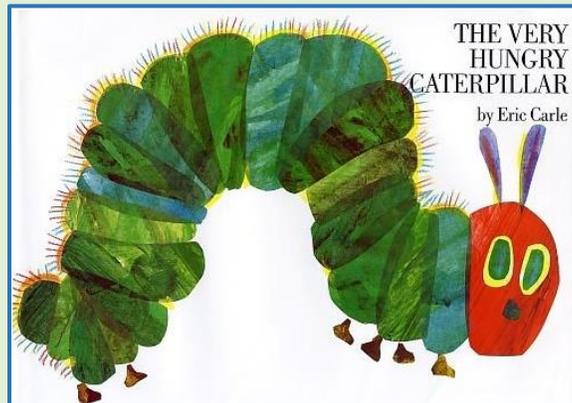


## Summer Reading for SK

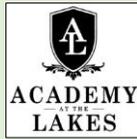
All the students will read ***The Very Hungry Caterpillar***. *(Please click on the picture to go to Amazon.com)*

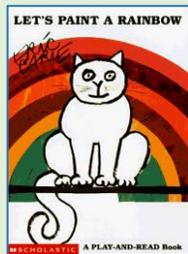

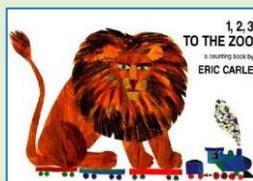
