



## Upper Division 2019-2020 Supply List

**IN GENERAL:** Please remember that school supplies are needed throughout the whole year. With that in mind, you may want to stock up now and retain this list to restock later in the year.

### Subject-specific supplies:

- English classes:** All classes need highlighters in 3 colors, ballpoint pens in black, blue and red, loose-leaf paper. In addition:
  - 9<sup>th</sup> grade: 1-** 1½ inch binder with pockets and set of clear tab dividers
  - 10<sup>th</sup> grade: 1-** 1 inch binder with pockets/clear front and set of clear tab dividers  
2 pkgs of 5 X 8 lined index cards;
  - 11<sup>th</sup> grade: 1-** 1-inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers.
  - 12<sup>th</sup> grade: 1-** 1-inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers. 2 pkgs of 5 X 8 lined index cards
- AP English Language for 11<sup>th</sup> graders and AP Literature and Composition for 12<sup>th</sup> graders:**  
1- 2 inch binder and a set of 5 dividers.
  
- Math classes** – a 1½ inch binder, loose leaf college-ruled paper, graphing paper (*geometry only*); ruler; pencils  
**Labeled Calculator: a TI83 or T-84 graphing calculator for all math courses-**
  
- History and Social Science classes:** a 1½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper; Black and/or blue ballpoint pens; 24 count Crayola Colored Pencils  
**AP History-** 3inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper.
  
- Foreign Language classes:**
  - Spanish I and Chinese:** 1½ inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper
  - Spanish II, French I, II, III:** Headphones, notebook or loose leaf paper with binder
  - Spanish III/IV/AP Regular and Honors-** 2 two-pocket folders; Headphones; notebooks; Dictionary- Spanish/English
  
- Integrated Physical Science:** 1 ½ inch binder, lined loose-leaf paper, 1 two pocket folder, notebook paper, set of 5 dividers
- For Science Fair:** one composition notebook with no labels or writing in it (students should not write their names on or in it), three-ring binder, 9 divider tabs, tri-fold presentation board
  
- Biology:** 3 ring binder or space in a binder for biology papers, loose leaf college ruled paper, at least 4 different colored writing utensils  
**For Science Fair:** one composition notebook with no labels or writing in it (students should not write their names on or in it), 1 inch three-ring binder, 9 divider tabs, tri-fold presentation board
  
- AP Biology: Calculator (4 function or graphing),** at least 4 different colored writing utensils
  
- Anatomy class:** Three ring binder (or space in a binder for anatomy papers), colored pencils

- Environmental Science:** Three ring binder (or space in a binder for environmental science materials), field-safe clothes that can get wet and dirty such as Columbia or a similar brand
- AP/Physics Honors classes:** 5 subject spiral notebook, 2 pocket folder, loose leaf college-ruled paper, graph paper; graphing calculator
- Chemistry:** Please see General Supplies
- HOPE class:** a 1 ½ inch duty binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper (You will also be asked to purchase Academy at the Lakes PE clothes: shorts and t-shirts. They will be available for sale on campus on Orientation Day.)
- Computer and Video Electives:** 32GB flash drive
- Studio Art classes:** Black hardbound sketchbook, 8.5" x 11", 75lb/110pages (Available at Walmart and Michael's)
- Theater classes:** 1 notebook; any size binder or folder to hold scripts
- Chorus:** a 1½ inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover
- Band class:** a 1 inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover; students must supply their own reeds for instruments
- Strings class:** a 1 inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover, 2 dozen plastic sheet protectors with 3-hole punch
- Yearbook/Digital Media:** A laptop (Mac or PC) with a full operating system on it. Tablets, Chromebooks, and other items that do not run a full version of Windows or Mac OS will not work. The laptop must have wifi capabilities and have enough memory and processor speed to handle Adobe Creative Cloud software. - Graphic Arts and Design (GAD):** 5x8 or larger spiral bound sketch pad

**General supplies each student must have:**

- Ball point pens (3 of each: *black, blue and red ink*)
- Mechanical pencils – 3-4; .7mm lead
- Colored Pencils
- #2 wooden pencils – 1 dozen
- Personal, hand-held pencil sharpener
- Highlighter markers (at least three different colors)
- Plenty of loose-leaf college-ruled paper for binders
- 1 Flash Drive – 32GB
- T-83 or T-84 Calculator
- Laptop - 9<sup>th</sup>-11<sup>th</sup> graders are required to have a laptop that meets Academy criteria.
- One backpack to transport items to and from school [Rolling backpacks are permitted]
- Certain specific supplies may be required in special classes or for special projects. Please follow specific instructions given by the teachers in August.***

Part of assignment completion is printing; students should print their assignments at home and bring them in. Please make sure you have a healthy supply of printer paper, printer ink cartridges and a working printer at home.
