



Academic Summer School Courses

Academy at the Lakes is proud to offer a variety of academic summer school courses for students interested in accelerating their studies over the summer. All courses are taught by our own AATL faculty through asynchronous online instruction. Students will work through the course content as created by their teacher and will have the opportunity to schedule one-on-one virtual meetings with their teacher each week. Each student has up to three hours of one-on-one virtual contact each week of the course. Unused hours do not roll over. Yearlong courses have a total of 24 one-on-one hours available over the 8-week session. Similarly, semester courses have a total of 18 one-on-one hours available over the 6-week session.

All students should have teacher approval before enrolling in an academic summer school course. We reserve the right to refund students who enroll without such approval. Students and families should be aware that completing a full year course in just 8 weeks is a difficult endeavor. Students should be able to work independently and at a quick pace. They must be committed to open communication about any issues they encounter and should be comfortable asking for help when needed. If a student begins a course and does not complete it successfully, there is no refund available. However, the course does not have to appear on the student's transcript.
