	All classes need highlighters in 5 colors, ballpoint pens in black and blue, pencils, a pack of multi-colored pens, loose-leaf paper, colored pencils, a package of expo markers, 2 packages of 5 x 8 index cards and Post-it notes. In addition:	
	9th grade: 1- 1½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets and set of clear tab dividers; 1 composition notebook.	
	10 th grade: 1- 1inch binder with pockets/clear front and set of clear tab dividers.	
	11 th grade: 1- 1-inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers. 1 composition notebook.	
	12 th grade: 1- ½ -inch binder or 1 notebook with pockets; 24 count markers.	
	AP English Language for 11 th graders: ½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets ad a set of dividers; 1 composition notebook.	
	AP Literature and Composition for 12 th graders : 1 ½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets and a set of 5 dividers; 1 composition notebook.	

Math Classes:

All classes require a $1\frac{1}{2}$ inch binder, loose leaf college-ruled paper, graphing paper (geometry only); ruler (geometry only); pencils; Labeled Calculator: a TI83 or T-84 graphing calculator for Precalculus and all AP Math.

	ALL History and Social Science Classes: All classes need highlighters in 5 colors, ballpoint pens in black and blue, colored pencils, and loose-leaf college ruled paper.	
	History and Social Science classes : a 1½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, 24 count Crayola Colored Pencils; 1-100 pack of white 4x6 index cards.	
	AP Human Geography and AP History: 2-inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper; 2-100 packs of white 4x6 index cards.

	Chinese: 1-two pocket paper folder, any color; 1 notebook.	
	Spanish I: 1½ inch heavy duty binder with clear plastic cover and 2 inside pockets, and a set of 5 dividers, loose leaf college-ruled paper; headphones.	
	Spanish II, French I, II, III: Headphones, loose leaf college-ruled paper or 1 composition notebook.	
	Spanish II Honors/ III & H/IV/AP Headphones; loose leaf college-ruled paper; Dictionary-Spanish/English	
Science:		
	Integrated Physical Science/ Physics Honors classes: Your choice of either a 1 ½ binder with a set of dividers OR a two-pocket folder and spiral notebook; loose leaf notebook paper, scientific calculator or better.	
	Biology/Biology H/AP Bio: 1- 1-inch binder, 5 pack of tabs, colored pencils, graph paper, loose leaf college ruled paper.	
	Marine Biology: 1-1-inch binder, pack of tabs, colored pencils, graph paper, loose leaf college ruled paper, field-safe clothes that can get wet and dirty such as Columbia or a similar brand.	
	AP Physics classes : 1 ½-inch or 2-inch binder with dividers, 2 pocket folder, loose leaf collegeruled paper, graph paper; graphing calculator, highlighter of some sort.	
	Chemistry/AP Chemistry: 1- 1 ½ inch binder with 2 inside pockets; college ruled paper, scientific/graphing calculator.

	HOPE class : a 1 ½ inch duty binder with 2 inside pockets, set of 5 dividers, loose leaf collegeruled paper (You will also be asked to purchase Academy at the Lakes PE clothes: shorts and tshirts. They will be available for sale on campus on Orientation Day.)

	Studio Art classes : Black hardbound sketchbook, 8.5" x 11", 75lb/110pages (Available at Walmart and Michael's)	
	Theater classes : 2-100 count index cards; post it notes, 2 packs of 12 Amazon Basic heavy-duty plastic 2 pocket folders assorted colors.	
	Chorus: a 1½ inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover	
	Band class : a 1inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover; students must supply their own reeds for instruments.	
	Strings class : a 1inch black binder with 2 inside pockets – no plastic sheet on cover, 2 dozen plastic sheet protectors with 3-hole punch	
	Video Production: A laptop (Mac or PC) with a full operating system on it. Tablets, Chromebooks, and other items that do not run a full version of Windows or Mac OS will not work.
